Derry’s Ciaran and Eamon Kelly bagged a total two trout weighing 4lb 11ozs, released six and lost six which took olive damsels with an orange bead. Glenullin’s Sean Kearney bagged three weighing 7lb 12ozs and released two which took little olives and white/grey dusters. Jonathan Selfridge (Maghera) released one which took a wee dry and unfortunately was teased by many trout nudging his fly but not taking it properly.
